- 1932 – 35 Studied Mathematics at the Sorbonne, Paris,  
1935 – 38 Studied at the École du Louvre and at various Academies before working in the Atelier of Fernand Léger, Paris  
1938 Moved to New York  
1938 – 39 Worked at the Art Students League with Vaclav Vytlacil Joined Stanley Hayter's Atelier 17, which had moved to New York  
Died in New York
